What scholarships do we have available?

As part of a shared ambition and intersectoral response to address domestic violence effectively and to support attendance and participation in the IDVH 2018 Melbourne conference, the IDVH Conference Committee is delighted to offer a limited number of scholarships to eligible applicants as follows:

1. Complimentary or discounted registration **OR**
2. Travel grant of up to \$500 AUD towards travel or accommodation.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander or other Indigenous peoples
- Individuals from low-income countries
- Survivors experiencing hardship

Please note that applicants with successful abstract submissions will be considered before those without accepted abstracts. Applications will be assessed on a case by case basis by the IDVH Conveners and notified of the outcome by email.

What do you need to include in your application?

- Your contact details – name and email, and position title and organisation, if applicable.
- A summary that addresses:
 - all the above relevant eligibility criteria,
 - your own expected learning outcomes from the conference, and
 - how your learnings might be applied in your own community or country.

This information is to be submitted using the online form available via the link at the top of this page.

How will the scholarship work?

In cases where the approved scholarship will contribute to the registration fee only, registration will be paid for you and no reimbursement will be provided. Where the approved scholarship contributes to accommodation and/or travel expenses, expenses of up to \$500 AUD will be reimbursed to the successful applicant, upon receipt of valid receipts and proof of participation at the conference.

Applicants will be notified of their application outcome 10 July 2018.
